Each week your child will be asked to practise a list of words. There is an activity for your child to complete. In addition to completing the activity in the booklet, your child may wish to continue to learn these words throughout the week. This may be achieved through a formal approach such as, look, cover, write, check, or by undertaking various creative activities.

For example this might include:

- Writing words in bath bubbles.
- Using chalks on the pavement.
- Making words using Lego or objects.
- Spelling words whilst on the way to school.
- Hunting for words around the garden

The list is endless!

Your child will need to be able to read and spell the words on the list given each week.

A teaching assistant will ask your child to read and spell these words and then, if they can read and spell the majority of the words correctly, they will be able to move onto the next word list.

Once your child has completed the whole booklet there will be a selection of board games or fun activities for your child to choose from. We ask that they continue to practise these words on a regular basis, choosing a variety of words from the word lists in this booklet.
