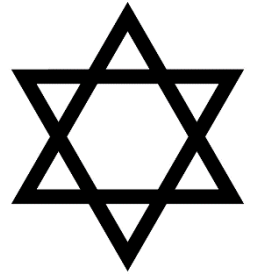


Year 5 RE Task - Spring Week 6

Passover is a celebration of the story of Exodus. During Passover, Jewish people remember how their ancestors left slavery behind them when they were led out of Egypt by a man named Moses. Passover is celebrated with a series of rituals. Each ritual symbolises a different part of the story.

The Seder Plate is a very important part of Passover. Using the resource on the next page, draw each of the foods on the Seder Plate and label them. Include a brief description of what each item represents.

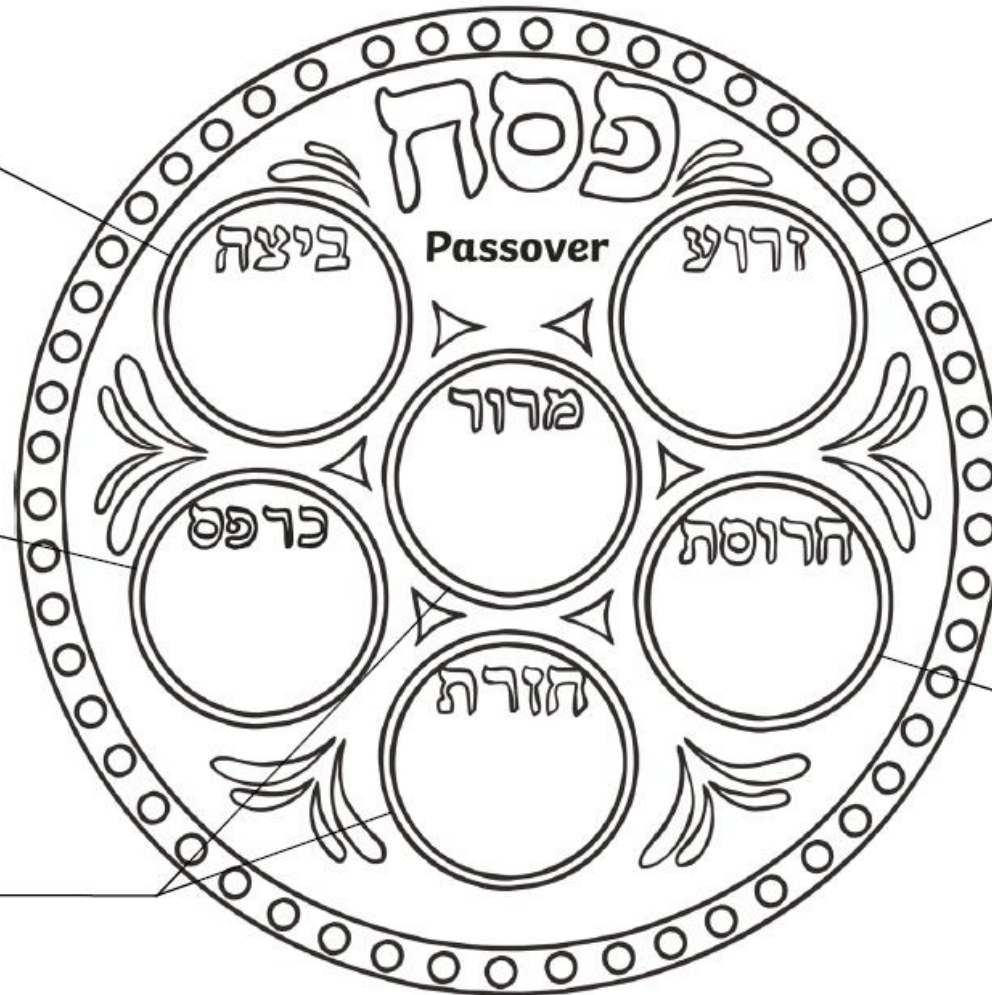
