Dear Parents and Carers of pupils in Reception Class

All children have been given a list of suggested homework activities to complete over the summer holiday (please see below). These activities have been discussed with your child during transition meetings and are intended to help prepare them for the year ahead. They should be handed in during the first week of the Autumn Term.

As your child is moving into Year 1 there is an expectation that they will complete some homework each week, in addition to reading regularly. Each Friday the children will bring home phonics homework, with maths homework every two weeks. Alongside this, children will receive wonderful word books with activities to complete at home. These are linked to the Year One common exception words. There will be a curriculum meeting for Year 1 parents on: **Wednesday 4th September at 2.30pm** to provide more details.

Additional information is available on the school website including a topic web which provides an overview of your child's learning across the year. These will be updated for September.

Pre- Year 1 Summer Homework Tasks:

- Visit the library and participate in the Summer Reading Challenge as well as reading books at home.
- Practise reading, writing and ordering numbers to at least 20.
- Choose your favourite fairy-tale, create a picture using different media, e.g. collage, paint or colouring pencils and write about one of the characters ready for our Autumn topic.
- Practise simple sentences
