We would like to remind you that EYFS 'Bookworm Reading' mornings will be starting on Thursday 5^{th} December, from 8.50am - 9.00am.

We hope you will be able to join us on an, 'as and when' basis. If you will need to bring a younger sibling with you please see the school guidelines below:

- Parents who wish to join the EYFS reading sessions, and have younger siblings, will agree to leave any buggies outside the EYFS classrooms (to keep fire exits clear).
- The reading session for children with younger siblings will take place in the library area (to maintain a calm reading environment in the classrooms).
- Parents will take full responsibility for the younger siblings and will leave the session if their child is disturbing other children/parents (a member of staff will be in the library and indicate if they feel this is appropriate).
- To support the safeguarding of our pupils no-one will use a mobile phone at any point when they are in the school buildings.
- We are given prior notice that you may bring a younger sibling to some (or all) of these sessions (so that we can accommodate everyone safely).

In the Spring term we will be looking at the timetable to see if we can change the day of the week this is held, to ensure as many people as possible get an opportunity to attend.
