COVID-19 Update-School Closures

Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you to everyone who has already provided us with most of the following information but late last night the Government printed a list of occupations that they are classing as **key workers**, so we need you to complete the form below. From Monday 23rd March 2020 the school will **only** be open to vulnerable pupils and pupils whose parents' occupations are included in the list below. The Government has also advised that if you do have child care at home this should be the first option to minimise the risk of spreading the infection.
